On Tuesday, Mike Foxworthy, AMI requested from our Board a review and advise.

On Friday, 28 May Barbara Lucas suggested it should be put in the newsletter.

On 29 May, Bob LaFary agreed with Barbara and suggested a group e-mail should go out due to the short time limit with the want and don’t wants.

On 29 May Richard Edwards agreed that Tim’s offer to consider special requests from residents should be transmitted as soon as possible. As it reads, his offer relates only to the question of whether people might wish to deny or limit trimming access to their shrubs or beds. Is it a presumption that his message may be more expansive than that, (i.e. “special requests” that might impact our budget, but I don’t think we should assume any meaning beyond a literal interpretation of what he said.

It is recommended Jeff relate Tim’s message literally with the additional caveat that Tim’s workers will trim the vegetation that is the responsibility of VWR unless the householder expressly opts to do the trim

ming instead. A possible weakness here is that we don’t know when the trimming would actually be happening and thus whether we have time to actualize this approach.

It was recommended by our Board Chairman the landscape committee compile a list of the shrub that do not need trimming and this could be passed on to our contractor for the September trimming..
